2022 Floor Demonstration

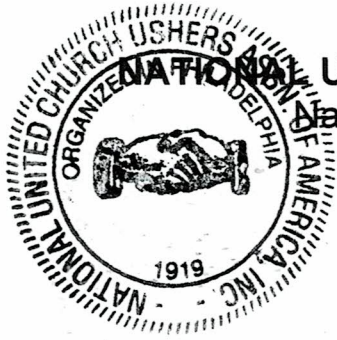
1. The Usher in Charge will get the attention of the doorkeeper and six ushers. Two ushers will go down aisle number 1, two ushers will go down aisle number 2, and two ushers will go down aisle number 3.
2. Aisle 1 ushers will give the signal for programs, aisle 2 ushers will give the signal for aisle information, aisle 3 ushers will give the signal for fans, all at the same time.
3. Usher in Charge will turn the aisle ushers for prayer.
4. Station 2 ushers in aisles 2 and 3 will give the sign for relief, all at the same time. The Usher in Charge will send relief ushers.
5. The doorkeeper will allow one guest to enter. The guest will go down aisle number 3. Station 1 usher will seat the guest two pews in front on the left.
6. Usher in Charge will turn the aisle ushers for scripture.
7. Usher in Charge will give the signal to the doorkeeper and the aisle users to come to the given point.

2022 Drill Competition

1. Six uniformed Ushers march onto stage in a single file and stop, all will go into service position. **Judging begins.**
2. All Ushers will make a right about face and receive an imaginary guest.
3. All Ushers will make a right about face, take two steps forward, make a right about face and seat guest on the left, all ushers make a right about face, and right face.
4. All Ushers will give the signal to face the pulpit.
5. All Ushers will make a right about face, make a right about face and go into prayer position. Come out of prayer position, go back into service position.
6. All Ushers will give the signal asking for available seats.
7. Ushers 1 and 5 will give the signal for (2) seats, Ushers 2 and 4 will give the signal for (3) seats and Ushers 3 and 6 will give signal for no seats. All at the same time.
8. All Ushers will make a right about face and give the Doorkeepers signal that a prayer is being rendered.
9. All Ushers make a right about face. Unfold letters.
10. Ushers 1, 3, and 5 will take one step back on the right foot. Ushers 2, 4, and 6 will take one step forward on left foot. (All at the same time). All Ushers will make a right about face, then right face.
11. Ushers 2, 4, and 6 will take one step forward on left foot. All come out of service position. **Judging ends!**.....March off stage in two's.

The Drill must be performed in 7 minutes or less.

2022 Floor Demonstration
